Want to Follow Him?

Making the decision to become a Christ follower is the most important decision one will make in their life. It is not to be taken lightly. Jesus warns us to count the cost before following Him. The cost is your life. A Christian's life is no longer their own, but is for Christ. For one to be saved, added to the Lord's church and identified as a Christian, the Bible informs us to:

- Hear the Word of God (Rom. 10:17).
- Have faith in God (Heb. 11:6).
- Repent of your sins (2 Cor. 7:10).
- Confess your faith in Christ (Rom.10:9,10). Be baptized for the remission of your sins (Acts

2:38; Mark 16:16).

After one becomes a Christian, they must continue to live faithfully to God. Your salvation can be canceled if the costs were not counted before becoming a Christian. Some keys to living faithfully include:
