### Want to Follow Him?

- Be baptized for the remission of your sins (Acts 2:38; Mark 16:16).

After one becomes a Christian, they must continue to live faithfully to God. Your salvation can be canceled if the costs were not counted before becoming a Christian. Some keys to living faithfully include:
